## General Regulations

The Montfort Cup 2016 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single Skating 2016 as well as all pertinent ISU Communications for the categories Seniors Juniors, Advanced Novice, and Basic Novice A and B and in accordance with ÖWO 2016 (Österreichische Wettlaufordnung).

All ISU-Members and all Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category und class. However, the Organizer shall have the right to limit the number of skaters from the invited Clubs, and split categories if the number of participants requires that.

## Liability

In accordance to ISU Constitution, rule 119, the Organizer accept no liability for bodily or personal injury, or for property loss or damage incurred by any Competitors or any kind of Officials.

## The code of Ethics

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU com. 1433. Action against this rule conducts behind itself the disqualification of skater.

## Prizes

The Trophy „Montfort-Cup Gesamtsieger“ will be awarded to the skaters with the highest total score (ladies/men), the three best placed skaters will get medals or trophies. The victory ceremonies will be held after the free programs of each category.

## Music

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on Audio CD format and all discs must show competitor's name, club and category. Each Program (short program, free skating) must be recorded on one track and on a separate disc. In addition, we highly recommend that competitors provide a back-up disc for each program.

## Technical Data

The Montfort Cup 2016 and the official Practices will be held at the „Vorarlberghalle“. Am Breiten Wasen 4, 6800 Feldkirch/Tosters The Ice Rink (30m x 60m) is indoor and non-heated.

## Planned Programm Content Sheet

The Program Content Sheet must be sent along with the Entry Forms to the Organizing Committee till the 20th of Nov. 2016.

## Draws

An electronic draw will take place latest on the previous day of the competition, starting orders will be published on our website: [www.fev-montfort.com](http://www.fev-montfort.com), and will also be sent by mail.

There will not be a draw after short programs. Starting order for free programs will be according to inverse of the results of short programs.

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Girls and Boys , born 30.06.2008 and younger  
Free skating: Boys, Girls 2min (+/- 10 sec.)

A well balanced CHICKS Free Skating Program must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for girls and boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted. Only two (2) jumps can be repeated in a jump combination or jump sequence. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- c) There must be a: Maximum of one (1) step sequence, utilizing at least half of the ice surface, with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only. Level explanation: For Chicks in all elements which, are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

- Performance/Execution

The factor of the Program Components is 2,5

<b>CUBS / JUGEND II</b>
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Girls and Boys, **born 01.07.2006 - 30.06.2008**

Free Skating: Boys, Girls 2 Min (+/- 10 Sec)

A well balanced CUBS Free Skating Program must contain:

- a) A maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only the two most difficult jumps will be counted. Only two (2) jumps can be repeated in a jump combination or jump sequence. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of

position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.

- c) There must be a: Maximum of one (1) step sequence, utilizing at least half of the ice surface, with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Level explanation: For Cubs in all elements which, are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.
